

WITS Changes – 15.5.0 Release (Mental Health)

In the 15.5.0 Release 3 bugs were repaired in WITS. Below are a summary of the errors and the resolutions of the problems.

- 1) Consented Activities: State machine exception error was occurring when viewing GAIN Short Screener report from consented activities list **Resolution:** An error screen no longer occurs when viewing a GAIN Short Screener from the consented activity list.
- 2) Claim Item: Yellow screen errors are being encountered when trying to add extra add-ons to Released Claim Items **Resolution:** A yellow screen no longer occurs when adding an 'add-on' to a released claim item.
- 3) Scheduler: "End After (#) of appointments not attended" on Edit Recurrence doesn't function properly **Resolution:** The "UpdateRecurringAppointments" nightly task was changed such that recurring appointments will no longer appear on the calendar once the designated "End after # of appointments not attended" is met.

Below you will find a summary of the changes to WITS for the 15.5.0 release (which took place May 1, 2014). When these changes are made in Idaho-Mountain and Idaho-Pacific, the top right portion of your screen will say 15.5.0.
