

WITS Changes – 17.23.1 Release (Mental Health)

In the 17.23.1 Release 5 bugs were repaired in WITS. Below are a summary of the errors and the resolutions of the problems.

- 1) Accessibility: Parts of E&M Notes not working with the JAWS screen reader. **Resolution:** E&M Notes is now compatible with JAWS. The Vital Signs, Mental Status Examination, and Medications screens have additionally been made compatible with JAWS as these screens have direct navigation links within E&M Notes.
- 2) Program Enrollment: Link to create Crisis Evaluation produces yellow screen for existing intake. **Resolution:** Users are now allowed to access the 'Crisis Evaluation' link in the administrative actions box on the program enrollment screen.
- 3) Consented Admission: Getting yellow screen errors. **Resolution:** User no longer getting yellow screen when clicked Review on Admission from the Consented Activity List.
- 4) Consented Intake: 'Is client under court supervision?' & 'Supervising County' fields are missing from Consented Intake. **Resolution:** "Is client under court supervision?" and "Supervising County" fields have been added.
- 5) Encounter: Show Obj #, Objective, and Comment columns as it did before on the Select Objective Screen (accessed from Add Objectives link on 2nd screen of Encounter). **Resolution:** The columns displayed on the Select Objectives screen have been reverted back to what they were prior to the 17.23 release; columns now again shown are Version#, Plan Dates, Obj #, Objective, and Comments.

The 17.23.1 release took place August 14, 2015. When these changes are made in Idaho-Mountain and Idaho-Pacific, the top left portion of your screen will say 17.23.1.
