

WITS Changes – 17.25.7 - 17.25.11 Releases - Mental Health

In the 17.25.7 - 17.25.11 Releases 13 bugs were repaired in WITS. Below are summaries of the errors and the resolutions of the problems.

- 1) Encounter: The encounter has been pre-populated with the most recent diagnosis from the diagnosis list. The Diagnosis list displays the diagnosis records for a Tx Plan that is 'Active-Not Signed Off' or 'Inactive-Draft' (where the diagnosis is missing). **Resolution:** The diagnosis list does not display the diagnosis records for a Tx Plan that is 'Active-Not Signed Off' or 'Inactive-Draft' and the expiration date for these are set to null. The diagnosis on the encounter pre-populates with the most recent diagnosis from all the activities.
- 2) Claim Item List: System gives error message when user tries to update a claim item whose encounter has the service date matching value of config parameter "Diagnosis.Icd10DiagnosisEffectiveDate". **Resolution:** Claim Item List: Fixed an error that would occur when releasing claim items when the related Encounter has an ICD diagnosis and a date equal to the ICD10 effective date.
- 3) Diagnosis: Non-clinical staff with just the role of Client Diagnosis are not able to add/edit diagnoses. **Resolution:** All users with a clinical role will be able to see the Diagnosis List Screen but only users with a role of Client Diagnosis will be able to add/edit diagnosis records. Non-clinical staff with just the role of Client Diagnosis are now able to add/edit diagnoses records without also requiring the Clinical Full role.
- 4) Diagnosis: Error message appears when primary diagnosis is filled in. **Resolution:** -Old Diagnosis records created before 7/20/15 is not displaying the error message and letting the users to save the Diagnosis.
- 5) Encounter: When created via Group Session or Scheduler, Diagnoses are not initially populated and Duration is not initially auto-calculated. **Resolution:** When creating an Encounter from a Group Session or the Scheduler, the Start Date, Start Time, and End Time that are pulled forward to pre-populate the corresponding fields on the Encounter will now trigger Diagnoses auto-population and Duration auto-calculation. Previously, Diagnoses were not populated based on Encounter Start Date and Duration not calculated based on Start/End Times until the screen refresh that occurs upon editing or re-selecting these field values.
- 6) Diagnosis: Diagnosis date/time not pre-populating correctly if they are backdated. **Resolution:** For the Treatment Plan and all Assessments, the Diagnosis Date/Time is now prepopulating correctly when the Activity date is backdated. Previously, for backdated activities, it prepopulated with the current date/time.
- 7) Diagnosis: Issues with ICD-9/10 codes pulled into Encounter. **Resolution:** Diagnoses code values that appear in the dropdowns will now be filtered out if the Diagnosis Effective Date is not within the diagnosis code's effective and expiration dates.

- 8) Admission: Unable to save "Homeless" living arrangement with the zip code '00000'. **Resolution:** Correctly allow users to save the Admission record if living arrangement is Homeless and zip code is 00000.
- 9) Diagnosis: Change dropdowns to start searching only after the user types in 2 characters. **Resolution:** Diagnosis: To improve performance, diagnosis dropdowns throughout the system will now display available selections only after at least 2 characters are entered.
- 10) Treatment Plan: Objectives do not show up on Encounter dated today when signed off Tx Plan is effective today and/or ends today. **Resolution:** Objectives will now show up on Encounters dated today when the Tx Plan effective date is today. In IA and CT, it additionally checks Tx Plan Activity time against Encounter start time.
- 11) Dispensary Module: optimization needed. **Resolution:** Auto query is removed for Administer Inventory screen. After improving the performance, functions work fine as usual on Administer Inventory and Dispensary Ordering screens.
- 12) Consent: When user creates a new consent, saves it and reviews it - Facility field is blank. **Resolution:** Fixed an issue where the value of "All Facilities" was not saving.
- 13) Discharge: Discharge Date is defaulting to today's date instead of Program Enrollment End Date. **Resolution:** Discharge Date will now default to the End Date of the most recent program enrollment. In CT only, Discharge Date will still default to the current date.

WITS Production sites will be updated with the 17.25.7 – 17.25.11 releases on November 09, 2015. When these changes are made in Idaho-Mountain and Idaho-Pacific, the top left portion of your screen will say 17.25.11.
