Discharge Expectations

- BPA is continuing to work with providers to streamline the discharge process. As the quarter ended yesterday, BPA will transition to a quarterly snapshot. Discharge requirements will be similar to the five day note process, with the connection to the incentive based on discharge numbers. Providers will have fifteen days to complete a discharge on any clients with thirty days of inactivity.

Provider Dashboard

- Regional coordinators have been supplied with the provider dashboard. This dashboard will give providers a snapshot of their facility's status; such as what number of clients each agency has, the discharges, length of stay, and discharge reasons. The dashboard will be provided the first quarter of fiscal year 16. For more information, contact BPA.

Follow up survey, preliminary information

The follow up survey will provide data regarding treatment effectiveness, and will supplement the TEDS/NOMS data from the admission and discharge. This is especially important for clients receiving treatment at residential facilities. The Survey will be delivered through WITS, and will offer an opportunity to reach out to clients that may be in danger of relapse.

The Follow up survey will be taken over the phone. It is approximately 20 short answer questions. DHW will pilot this project in the next weeks/months.

Communications will be sent out before implementation. A training plan is underway and will be announced. For those clients who complete a GPRA, the follow ups will not be required.

ATR 4 Updates

- Access to Recovery has expanded the Veteran Eligibility to include those who are not on supervised probation or parole. Veterans will now have access to ATR 4 funding if they are unable to access VA benefits because of discharge status, location, war/combat experience or other concerns.
- As of August 31st, almost \$602,000 has been spent on recovery and support services. The majority of the population served has been homeless, and we expect the unsupervised Veteran's population to grow quickly as the parameters for qualification have been expanded.
- As this is the last day of the first year of the ATR 4 grant, we're looking for stories or experiences in how this grant has affected clients in a positive way. Success stories will not only strengthen
