System Enhancements:

Website update-the WITS.idaho.gov site will be changing in the near future. E-mail updates sent to providers upon change to the website currently take the, to the announcement page. The new layout will allow users to go directly to where the page was changes; the users will need to subscribe to receive the notifications. They can follow the link listed in the e-mail and it will take them directly to the changes.

The WITS BETA site has been out for a while. Users are asked to continue to submit any issues or problems that they encounter on the WITS.idaho.gov site. The rollout date is still is certain. Jamie Teeter inquired if any of the providers are using the BETA site. A few providers indicated that they were.

The WITS 15.9 and 15.10 releases are almost complete. The releases to billing error which makes the user save when they to go back into note, even if changes were not made has been corrected. An address check has been added where the client address entered in the Client Profile is now verified against the USPS database, and a recommendation will be made based on that check.

The 15.10 release will be pushed to production on Monday. The release notes will be posted to www.wits.idaho.gov under the System Errors tab.

Jamie Teeter inquired if anyone does look at the release notes. Many of the providers indicated that they do not have time to do that and most of the information is “greek” to them. Providers were asked that if you have any problems to contact the WITS Help Desk.
