

WITS Changes – 17.25.6 Release (SUD)

9/28/2015

In the 17.25.6 Release 6 bugs were repaired in WITS. Below are a summary of the errors and the resolutions of the problems.

- 1) Vital Signs: Clicking 'Finish' does not return user to the previous screen. **Resolution:** User is returned to the Activity List screen when clicking Finish on Vital Signs screen which has been accessed from the Navigation Menu.
- 2) Billing: An Encounter with an End Date past the Authorization End Date can be released. **Resolution:** An Encounter with an End Date that is later than the associated Authorization End Date can no longer be released.
- 3) GPRA Follow-up Due: Filtering for "GPRA 3 Month Follow-up" in ATR4 returns results. **Resolution:** When the user is filtering the list for "3 Month Follow-up" in ATR Grant, no result is returned, and the system throws up an error message stating "ATR does not have a 3 Month Follow-up. Please select 6 Month."
- 4) Authorization Dashboard: Multiple issues in the Authorization Dashboard. **Resolution:** Authorization Dashboard is now filtering by facility and the "Auth End Date" turns red when Today – "Auth End Date" \leq 14 days either in the past or future.
- 5) Reports: Users were getting a yellow screen error when trying to run the 'Adjudication Results' report. **Resolution:** The Adjudication Report no longer times out (yellow screen) when run.
- 6) Billing: Claim batches should not be marked as Billed when the batch has no claim items. **Resolution:** An error message will now be displayed upon clicking 'Bill It' or 'Send To Clearing House' for a claim batch that does not include any claim items. This rule is being implemented to avoid 837 Processor failures downstream.

Below you will find a summary of the change to WITS for the 17.25.6 release (which took place September 28, 2015). When these changes are made in Idaho-Mountain and Idaho-Pacific, the top left portion of your screen will say 17.25.6.



Diagnosis

WITS has been updated to accommodate ICD-10/DSM-5 values. The diagnosis dropdown fields have been modified to filter displayed values based on the effective/expiration dates for ICD codes. On Diagnosis Type, ICD-9 Axis I & Axis II have been mapped to Behavioral, Axis III has been mapped to Medical, and Axis IV has been mapped to Psychosocial.
