

## WITS Changes – 16.0.0 and 16.1.0 Release (SUD)

In the 16.0.0 and 16.1.0 Releases 9 bugs were repaired in WITS. Below are a summary of the errors and the resolutions of the problems.

- 1) Alert Configuration: Display warning on changing parameters **Resolution:** Warning message stating that changes made will not affect prior alerts is now displayed when one of the following fields is updated:
  - a. "Alert should stop being displayed this many days after it is generated:"
  - b. "How many days prior to the due date should this alert show up?"
  - c. "When is the next activity due (days after the trigger point)?"
- 2) Admission: "Months employed... in last 12 months" on Financial/Household Screen not Allowing Values >6 (ID) **Resolution:** For substance abuse, just as is already happening for mental health and children's mental health, the "Months employed... in last 12 months" field on the Financial/Household screen will now allow values less than or equal to 12.
- 3) Claim Item List: Slow Performance Returning Search Results **Resolution:** Implemented database and code changes to improve search performance.
- 4) Admission: Shouldn't be able to save an Admission with a date prior to Intake date **Resolution:** Fixed an issue where Admission could be saved with an Admission date prior to Intake date. It now throws an error message upon save in this scenario.
- 5) Client Profile: Error in state code submission causing odd values to be returned **Resolution:** fixed an issue where the address validation was not being narrowed down correctly.
- 6) Billing - Claims Management: Clicking 'Finish' or 'Cancel' on Encounter takes you back to wrong Claim Item **Resolution:** Clicking 'Finish' or 'Cancel' on Encounter Error in which system takes the user back to a wrong Claim Item has been fixed
- 7) Support Ticket: 'End User' drop down box is not being filtered so there are too many in the list **Resolution:** 'End User' drop down box is now being filtered by Agency selected.
- 8) Program Enrollment - Yellow screen error when selecting a TEDS program. **Resolution:** Fixed an error that would occur when selecting a TEDS program without an Admission record.
- 9) Intake: Initial Contact Type dropdown field is empty on Intake screen if the client has more than one Episode Intake **Resolution:** Initial Contact Type dropdown field now has options on Intake screen even if the client has more than one Episode Intake

Below you will find a summary of the changes to WITS for the 16.0.0 and 16.1.0 releases (which took place July 28, 2014). When these changes are made in Idaho-Mountain and Idaho-Pacific, the top right portion of your screen will say 16.1.0.
