

## WITS Changes – 18.2.6 Release (SUD)

In the 18.2.6 Release 8 bugs were repaired in WITS. Below are a summary of the errors and the resolutions of the problems.

- 1) Menus: Not displaying upon refresh. **Resolution:** Implemented a change to get around an Internet Explorer error (in IE10 or earlier versions) that was causing the left menu links to be hidden when search screens return a large number of records.
- 2) Claim Item: Getting warning message when reviewing a reversed claim item. **Resolution:** The warning message 'The number of units for this service is too low. Minimum number of units that can be billed for this service is 1.' no longer appears for reversals.
- 3) Program Enrollment: Updated Admission substance info doesn't update on program enrollments. **Resolution:** On Insert, WITS will pull substance data from admission into Program Enrollment. In update mode, the Program Enrollment screens will display the substances from the program enrollment table. For customers that do program enrollment based TEDS reporting, the Substance Abuse fields will be editable on the Program Enrollment screen.
- 4) Scheduler: Yellow error screen when creating Group Session from Scheduler. **Resolution:** A yellow screen no longer occurs when creating or viewing a group session from a scheduled group appointment.
- 5) WITS: Accessibility Scan. **Resolution:** Implemented modifications as follows to make JAWS compatible with EA Architecture changes introduced in the 18.0 release:
  - ~ The left menu is now JAWS compatible again.
  - ~ 'Fetching' dropdowns are now JAWS compatible again.
  - ~ Dual list box fields are now JAWS compatible again.
  - ~ List titles are now read.
  - ~ 'Export' links are now read with more info regarding the corresponding list.
  - ~ For Maine: Admission and Discharge modules are now JAWS compatible.
- 6) Various: Drop down boxes are too narrow to view selected values. **Resolution:** Fixed the issue where the drop down fields are too narrow to select the values. It is now fixed to show the drop down fields with appropriate width.
- 7) Yellow Page Errors: Miscellaneous Note Detail, Follow up & Discharge from the Consented Activity List and Generate Report from Discharge. **Resolution:** Fixed yellow page errors that occurred while accessing the Miscellaneous Note Detail, Follow up & Discharge from the Consented Activity List and also the Generate Report from the Discharge screen.
- 8) Program Enrollment: If a client is referred using plan based authorizations to a program that reports to TEDS, once the Admission is complete, the TEDS/NOMS data does not populate on the Program

Enrollment. **Resolution:** The issue reported in this work item, where TEDS/NOMS data does not populate once the Admission is complete when stemming from a referred plan based authorization, was introduced by work item #27183 in the 18.2 release. As a resolution, we have backed out the changes from the aforementioned work item and will re-address that issue (updated admission substance info not updating on program enrollments) in an upcoming release.

Below you will find a summary of the change to WITS for the 18.2.6 release (which took place January 9, 2016). When these changes are made in Idaho-Mountain and Idaho-Pacific, the top left portion of your screen will say 18.2.6.



## Notes

New navigation controls have been added to the Encounter screen to move from one Encounter record to another without going back to the list. This capability is not enabled in instances with custom encounter screens. (WI# 16430)
