

WITS Changes – 17.6.0 Release (SUD)

11/10/2014

In the 17.6.0 Release 6 bugs were repaired in WITS. Below are a summary of the errors and the resolutions of the problems.

- 1) Program Enrollment: Case Closed- "Enroll in Concurrent Program" Link remains available. **Resolution:** If the currently selected intake is closed, the "Enroll in Concurrent Program" and "Transfer to another program" links no longer appear.
- 2) Staff List: Intermittently getting yellow screen error when resetting credentials. **Resolution:** Fixed an issue where users would intermittently get an error when resetting credentials.
- 3) Scheduler: Values get cutoff in 'Procedure' dropdown box when an extremely long Description exists in 'Procedure' code table. **Resolution:** Fixed the issue where the values are being cutoff in 'Procedure' drop down box when a long description exists. The value no longer goes off the screen.
- 4) Program Enrollment: waitlist end date is allowed to be prior to waitlist start date when populated by program enrollment. **Resolution:** Fixed the issue where the Waitlist end date was allowed prior to start date. On the program Enrollment, when user enters the start date prior to the waitlist start date, it throws an error message so user can go back and change the waitlist start date.
- 5) Claim Item: Yellow page on Reversing and Adjusting the claim item. **Resolution:** Yellow page no longer appears while Reversing and Adjusting the Claim Item.
- 6) My Settings: Change Password/PIN: Users are unable to cancel. **Resolution:** Users now have the ability to cancel out of a Change Password/PIN process.

Below you will find a summary of the change to WITS for the 17.6.0 release (which took place November 12, 2014). When these changes are made in Idaho-Mountain and Idaho-Pacific, the top left portion of your screen will say 17.6.0.



Assessment



In order to start a GAIN assessment, you must do the following:
 1. Complete Client Profile Module in WITS. My GAIN password: test
 2. Use the Sync Client Information action button below to send the Client Profile information to GAIN.
 3. When you receive an information message that the record was "Successfully Synced", click on the Perform GAIN Assessment action button to launch a GAIN window. You will need a GAIN account to do this. (If you don't have a GAIN Account, please call your WITS Administrator).
 4. After completing one of the GAIN Assessments, click the Download / Update GAIN Summaries action button, which will pull the GAIN information back into WITS so that it can become part of the Client's electronic medical record.
 5. To view a completed GAIN Summary, click the Review action button.
 6. If you are doing a GAIN-M90 Assessment, click the action item Create GAIN-M90 Activity after performing the assessment in the GAIN ABS system. This will create an activity record for this client's GAIN-M90 Assessment.
