

# Modality Check on Releasing an Encounter Note to Billing

Starting June 16, 2015, WITS will check when a user releases an encounter note to billing for clients in the Substance Abuse treatment domain that the selected service is approved for the program enrollment modality type.

If the service is approved for the modality of the selected program enrollment, users will not see any difference. If a user tries to release an encounter to billing when the selected service is not approved for the modality of the selected program enrollment, they will receive the error message 'This service is not valid under this treatment program' and will not be able to release the encounter to billing.
